Referral Process	Most women refer themselves to the program directly. Referrals may also be initiated by family members, friends, health care professionals, community agencies, employee assistance programs or legal representatives. Involvement with any of the treatment components is up to the woman. The team completes a telephone assessment with the woman prior to any admission. An admission will be arranged based on the availability of beds and/or a referral will be made to a more appropriate program. Women admitted to the program are consciously fit, able to get around and medically stable.
